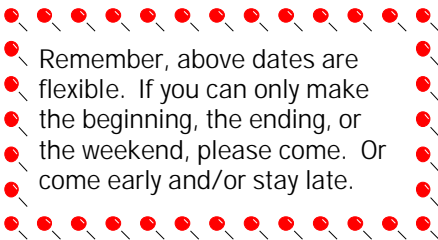
**Alfa National Rally

The attendees were: Hans & Brunhilde Butterwegge, Ted & Doreen Hixon, Keith Hofer & Joann Smith, Don & Marilyn Polen and Ron & Carol Davis as the substitute Nat'l Board Members as well as substitute WagonMasters. A great time was had by all. The Rally was held at a huge entertainment complex, the Cam-Plex where we had one entire wing as well as all the RV sites. There were approximately 235 rigs, most from the Western Clubs. The Roadrunners, who were the host club, numbered 120 rigs. There are more and more motorhomes attending the rallies and the 5th Wheels were outnumbered about 3 to 1. We had three excellent meals provided. The Welcome Dinner, Wednesday, the first nite was buffalo burgers and Sunday dinner, baked chicken were both served buffet style. The farewell dinner, was table service, and a wonderful Western Prime Rib, provided by the local Alfa Dealers. **ALFA SUNRISERS
BYLAWS**

Adopted September 19, 1998 in Lebanon, Maine
Amended April 26, 1999 in Manteca, California
Amended April 10, 2000 in Luling, Texas
Amended January 10, 2002 in Panama City Beach, Florida
Amended May 16, 2003 in Sevierville, TN
Amended September 8, 2004 in Gettysburg, PA

ARTICLE I NAME

This organization is a chapter of the National ALFA Owners Club Sundancers, sanctioned by ALFA Leisure, Inc., Chino, California. The name of this chapter shall be the Alfa Sunrisers Club, or Sunrisers for brevity.

ARTICLE II PURPOSE

The purpose of the SUNRISERS shall be the promotion of good fellowship, fun and companionship among members, the exchange of information and ideas to enhance the enjoyment of RV Camping in an ALFA Trailer or Motorhome.

ARTICLE III MEMBERSHIP

Section 1 A. An applicant for membership must be the owner on an ALFA RV, and use, or advocate the use of an ALFA RV, as a camping Vehicle.

B. Any member in good standing may retain membership by continuing to submit annual dues on or before April 30 of the current year.

Section 2 A. Dues shall be \$20.00 per unit per year, and are due and payable at the time of becoming a member and/or before April 30 of each year thereafter.

B. \$5.00 of the above \$20 shall be designated to pay mileage for the chapter NBD Representative to attend the National Board Meeting held the day after National.

C. New members whose dues are paid after September 30 are credited for the following year.

D. Special Assessments may be made and assigned as necessary and voted on by the attending membership at the meeting where proposed. The Special Assessment can be either Mandatory or Voluntary as determined at the meeting. Special Assessments shall be levied to the entire general membership.

Section 3 A. A member shall be dropped from the club for the following reasons:

1. Nonpayment of dues after sixty (60) days delinquency.
2. Causing a disturbance or not complying with park rules, if such actions reoccur after a warning from the Wagon Master or a Club Officer.

Section 4 Copies of the Bylaws are to be included once a year with a copy of the Gazette Newsletter, or by request.

ARTICLE IV OFFICERS

Section 1 The Officers shall be: President, Vice President, Secretary-Treasurer, National Board of Directors (NBD) Representatives, and Editor. Husband and wife may each be an officer. Each occupant of an ALFA is eligible to hold any office in the SUNRISERS Club.

Section 2 Duties:

A. President: The President shall conduct all meetings of the membership. He/She shall appoint all committees and any special committee deemed necessary for the betterment of the Club or SUNRISERS in general. The President shall send welcoming letters to new Sunriser club members. He/She shall coordinate club leadership. He/She shall appoint officers to fill any unexpired terms.

B. Vice President: The Vice President shall act in behalf of the President, in the President's absence. The Vice President shall maintain the Outing Schedule and provide information about upcoming outings to the Newsletter Editor. He/She shall Coordinate Outings and find Wagonmasters, or will appoint the responsibility.

C. Secretary-Treasurer: The Secretary-Treasurer shall record minutes and keep them in the official club records. The Secretary-Treasurer shall also be responsible for receiving dues and other funds, and maintaining membership records. The Secretary-Treasurer shall disburse funds at the discretion of the President or majority vote of the members present at any publicized meeting. The Secretary-Treasurer shall furnish a financial statement at regular meetings.

D. National Board of Directors (NBD) Representatives: The NBD Representatives shall attend National Board meetings to present the Sunriser Club interests. Mileage to the annual NB meeting is to be reimbursed by the Sunrisers Chapter, up to the amount collected by Art. 3, Sect. 2B. Mileage to the mid-year NB meeting is reimbursed by Alfa Leisure.

E. Alternate National Board of Directors Representatives: The Alternate NBD Representatives shall attend National Board meetings when the NBD Representatives are unable to attend.

F. Editor: The editor shall be responsible for publishing the Gazette Newsletter. It is customary but not mandatory for the Newsletter to be published quarterly. The Newsletter shall include news ideas and information received from SUNRISERS as well as reports of club activities or such other items as the Editor or Officers wish to include.

Section 3 Term of Office

- A. The term of office for all elected officers, except National Board Representatives, shall be eighteen (18) months.
- B. Two NBD Representatives (Primary) and two Alternate NBD Representatives shall be elected for a term of three years, as the term of the previous NBD representatives expire.
- C. There shall be no limit on the number of consecutive terms an Officer may remain in office.

Section 4 Election of Officers

- A. Election of Officers shall be conducted at any Alfa Sunriser Outing with the exact month to be designated by the President. Nominations for officers shall be made by the vacating Officer. Nominations for officers may also be made by a nominating committee, or by members from the floor.
- B. Election of officers shall be by a majority of the membership present.

ARTICLE V ACTIVITIES

- Section 1
 - A. There shall be a minimum of four (4) campouts per year, in addition to the annual ALFA Rally. Each campout shall be headed by a member who shall be called the "Wagon Master".
 - B. Each member shall be willing to volunteer as Wagon Master to organize a campout.
 - C. The date and place of the campout shall be deemed by the Wagon Master, however, one campout, if practical, shall be held at a date and place to facilitate attendance at the annual ALFA Rally.
 - D. The Wagon Master shall make sure there is sufficient room for 40' RV's, if needed, and possibly triple slide outs.
 - E. All members of the Sunrisers and other chapters of the Sundancers shall be welcome at all campouts on a space available basis. Members who wish to participate in the annual ALFA Rally activities must be registered for the Rally and have their ALFA RV's on site for each day of participation.
 - F. Guests, in their rig or a SUNRISERS rig will be welcome at all campouts, except the annual ALFA Rally, provided space is available as determined by the Wagon Master.
 - G. To recapitulate: Wagon Master will be responsible for the following:
 - 1. Selection of a site and date for a campout.
 - 2. Securing and making a deposit when required.
 - 3. Insure campsites are ready and arrange for parking of rigs.
 - 4. Insure that the Editor has all details about the campout to be included in the Gazette newsletter.

ARTICLE VI AMENDMENTS

- Section 1 Amendments to these bylaws can be made at any regular meeting. If possible, timely notice of the proposed change or changes shall be published in the Gazette Newsletter.
- Section 2 Amendments shall be by a vote with a simple majority of the members present required.
- Section 3 Any changes to the bylaws will be published in the Sunrisers Gazette after approval by membership present at a SUNRISERS meeting.

ARTICLE VII AUDIT COMMITTEE

- Section 1 Prior to the election of Officers, the President shall appoint an Audit Committee of up to three (3) members to examine the financial records of the SUNRISERS Club before the business/election meeting, and report their findings to the membership at the chapter campout.

ARTICLE VIII WAGON MASTER FUND

- Section 1 Wagon Master Fund is comprised of registration fees paid to him/her by members attending each campout. The deposit sent with Registration consists of the park charges for one nights lodging plus a registration fee. Registration fees are to be used by the Wagon Master for campout expenses such as B.B.Q., Pancake breakfast, Coffee, Etc.
