# Hooks and Bytes

## By Webmaster Dan Harvey



Hello Friends!

The Tampa RV Show allowed me to spend a great deal of time with several of our members on a one on one basis. We set up several mail boxes and I got valuable feedback from those folks who have recently started using their Sunriser's Email. Everyone seems very pleased with the results.

A new option has been added to our web site. On the very first page (aka "Click to Enter" page) scroll down to the bottom and click on the icon labeled "Map of Site Visitors" which opens a world map with thumb tacks depicting locations of the last 100 visitors to the site. If you zoom in, you can see the map is fairly specific as to your location. It is not exact, but pretty close. Most likely, you will also see our site has had visitors from other countries. This is because we are now reaching many search engines on an international basis.

Sitenet BBS has released a new version of their software. I usually allow some time for them to get the bugs worked out before I install it on our system. In the past, the updates have only affected the maintenance of the system and I assume this version is no different. We use this software for our Forums.

You may be interested to know that I have found a wireless Router made by LinkSys (Cisco) that may be of interest to some of you. This box works just like all home access points but has the ability to use your cellular data card in addition to a DSL or Cable Modem connection. It is about the easiest way I have seen to setup a WiFi network within your RV. In fact, if your home is located where there is a strong high-speed cell signal, then you might not need cable or DSL internet at home. Just use this device!

It is a "Wireless-G Router" Model No. WRT54G3G-AT. I think the "AT" means it is for AT&T wireless service which is my personal carrier and I assume they are available for all carriers. MSRP is about \$250 but I paid \$150 on the internet.

A few words about "N" technology and what it means to WiFi. Simply put, it's bigger and faster than "B" or "G" technology. Some manufacturers boast a 10X increase on coverage area and a 4X increase in speed. If you have a few "dead" zones in your home WiFi network, then it is very likely that purchasing a "N" Router will fix the problem without the expense or trouble of relocating or adding additional access points. Janet had G technology at her home in Tennessee which was borderline coverage for my Alfa parked out on the driveway. The fix was to simply install an N Router in the same location as the old G Router. The stronger N Router fixed the distance problem.

Also, we noticed during our vacation last summer that most hotels in Nova Scotia and New Brunswick use N WiFi which is apparently accepted on a broader basis than here in the U.S.

Dan Harvey and Janet Davis will be hosting a Sunriser Mini (Rolling) Rally which assembles in Natchez Mississippi on May 29th., And arrives in Nashville Tennessee on June 3rd.. Travel will be along the complete length of the historic Natchez Trace with a side trip to Vicksburg National Battlefield and Cemetery. ### **Herb Mix**

0.75 ounce jar of Italian seasoning  
1 Tbl spoon Lemon Pepper  
1 Tbl spoon dry minced garlic  
5 Tbl Turkey Seasoning [Chief Merito]

Blend all ingredients with Magic Wand [or similar tool]  
Will keep up to 1 year in freezer. Good for use with poultry,  
sea food, vegetables or to make a dip.



### **Grilled Ham**

2-ham steaks 1/2-3/4 inch thick slices  
1-cup brown sugar  
1/2-cup horse radish  
1/4- cup lemon juice

Stirring well bring to a boil all ingredients (except ham)

side) Baste frequently with brown sugar/horse radish mixture

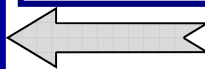

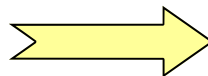
